BOTANICAL NAME \_\_\_\_\_ *Heuchera* 'Canyon Delight' x *H. elegans*

CULTIVAR NAME \_\_\_\_\_ 'Canyon Duet'

COMMON NAME \_\_\_\_\_ Canyon Duet Coral Bells

FAMILY NAME \_\_\_\_\_ Saxifragaceae

ORIGIN \_\_\_\_\_ *Heuchera* 'Canyon Delight' x *H. elegans* selected by Horticulturist Dara Emery.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION \_\_\_\_\_ Evergreen, compact, matlike herbaceous perennial. Leaves 1.25 inch wide in rosettes 12+ inches across and 5 inches tall. Strongly bicolored flowers of pink and white on 12-18 inch stalks in spring.

WATER REQUIREMENTS \_\_\_\_\_ Summer water required.

SOIL REQUIREMENTS \_\_\_\_\_ Best in loamy soil.

EXPOSURE REQUIREMENTS \_\_\_\_\_ Best in part shade.

PESTS AND DISEASES \_\_\_\_\_ Susceptible to mealybugs in containers, and thrips.

HARDINESS \_\_\_\_\_ All Zones.

LANDSCAPE VALUE \_\_\_\_\_ Small-scale groundcover, edging plant, appropriate in rock gardens or in decorative containers.

PROPAGATION \_\_\_\_\_ Cuttings or division: Divide clumps every 3 or 4 years in fall (in spring in colder areas). Discard older, woody rootstocks.

\_\_\_\_\_ To commercially propagate this introduction, interested nurseries need to sign a licensing agreement with the Santa Barbara Botanic Garden.

SALES POTENTIAL \_\_\_\_\_ 'Canyon Duet' is a charming, diminutive, sturdy cultivar with distinct bicolored flowers.
